

Rx for Healing

As you prayerfully, respectfully, and expectantly read the following verses of scripture that promise you healing from God, take note of which verses seem to spark hope and faith in your heart. Whichever set of verses seem to have extra inspiration on them as you read them, THAT is the Holy Spirit talking to you. Those particular verses are God's personal promise to you and should give you an indication of HOW God will heal you and through which point of contact He wishes for you to receive your healing.

A Word About Doctors And Medicine

To look to God for healing and health DOES NOT mean that you should throw away your medicine or eyeglasses. Divine healing and natural healing are not antithetical. Jesus praised the people who trusted Him for supernatural healing through faith. And He also praised the good Samaritan for treating the wounded man through the best hospital care and medical treatment of that day. All healing comes from God. He created our bodies to heal naturally. He created our immune systems. He created our bodies so that they would respond to certain chemicals, nutrients, surgeries, and treatments. So it is perfectly legitimate to seek health from God as your ultimate Source both through the medical profession and the scriptures. God heals through prayer and faith. God heals through exercise and nutrition. God heals through medical attention. The bottom line is that **GOD WANTS YOU WELL! PERIOD!** And God wants you to look beyond the methods of healing to Him as the Source of all your health! God heals through many methods!

Healing - A Finished Work Of The Cross

1 Peter 2:24-25 Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed. For ye were as sheep going astray; but are now returned unto the Shepherd and Bishop of your souls.

Isaiah 53:4-6 Surely he hath borne our griefs (Hebrew: choliy- "sickness, disease"), and carried our sorrows (Hebrew: makob- "pain"): yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. But he [was] wounded for our transgressions, [he was] bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace [was] upon him; and with his stripes we are healed. All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the LORD hath laid on him the iniquity of us all.

Matthew 8:16-17 When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits with [his] word, and healed all that were sick: That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, Himself took our infirmities, and bare [our] sicknesses.

Healing - The Loving and Redemptive Nature Of Your God.

Psalms 103:1-5 Bless the LORD, O my soul: and all that is within me, [bless] his holy name. Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits: Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases; Who redeemeth thy life from destruction; who crowneth thee with lovingkindness and tender mercies; Who satisfieth thy mouth with good [things; so that] thy youth is renewed like the eagle's.

Acts 10:38 How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.

Ps 107:20 He sent his word, and healed them, and delivered [them] from their destructions.

Exodus 23:25-26 And ye shall serve the LORD your God, and he shall bless thy bread, and thy water; and I will take sickness away from the midst of thee. There shall nothing cast their young, nor be barren, in thy land: the number of thy days I will fulfil.

Ex 15:26 ...I [am] the LORD that healeth thee.

Proverbs 3:7,8 (Amplified Bible) Be not wise in your own eyes; reverently fear and worship the Lord, and turn entirely away from evil. It shall be health to your nerves and sinews, and marrow and moistening to your bones.

Acts 9:34 And Peter said unto him, Aeneas, Jesus Christ maketh thee whole: arise, and make thy bed. And he arose immediately.

Malachi 4:2 But unto you that fear my name shall the Sun of righteousness arise with healing in his wings; and ye shall go forth...

Healing - The Will Of God For All

John 14:9 Jesus saith unto him, ...he that hath seen me hath seen the Father...

Lu 5:12-13 And it came to pass, when he was in a certain city, behold a man full of leprosy: who seeing Jesus fell on [his] face, and besought him, saying, Lord, if thou wilt, thou canst make me clean. And he put forth [his] hand, and touched him, saying, I will: be thou clean. And immediately the leprosy departed from him.

Mt 7:11 If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children, how much more shall your Father which is in heaven give good things to them that ask him?

James 1:17 Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning.

Luke 11:10 For every one that asketh receiveth; and he that seeketh findeth; and to him that knocketh it shall be opened.

Mt 12:15 Jesus, aware of this, withdrew from there. And many followed him, and he healed them all,

Healing - Through The Laying On Of Hands

Mark 16:15-20 And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils...they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover. So then after the Lord had spoken unto them, he was received up into heaven, and sat on the right hand of God. And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord working with [them], and confirming the word with signs following. Amen.

Healing - Through The Prayer Of Faith With Anointing Oil

James 5:14-16 Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord: And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him. Confess [your] faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.

Healing - Through Believing Prayer

Jeremiah 17:14 Heal me, O LORD, and I shall be healed; save me, and I shall be saved: for thou [art] my praise.

Psalms 30:2 O LORD my God, I cried unto thee, and thou hast healed me.

Mark 11:22-25 And Jesus answering saith unto them, Have faith in God. For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith. Therefore I say unto you, What things soever ye desire, when ye pray, believe that ye receive [them], and ye shall have [them]. And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses.

Sickness and Disease - Its Evil Origin. Healing - Its Good Source.

Acts 10:38 How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.

Healing - Speak Aloud To The Disease, Demanding Its Removal

Mark 11:23 For verily I say unto you, That whosoever shall say unto this mountain, Be thou removed, and be thou cast into the sea; and shall not doubt in his heart, but shall believe that those things which he saith shall come to pass; he shall have whatsoever he saith.

James 4:7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.

Healing - Through Standing On The Word And Boldly Speaking The Word Over Your Condition

Psalms 107:2 Let the redeemed of the LORD say [so], whom he hath redeemed from the hand of the enemy;

Matthew 8:8 The centurion answered and said, Lord, I am not worthy that thou shouldest come under my roof: but speak the word only, and my servant shall be healed.

Psalms 91:2 I will say of the LORD, [He is] my ...

Hebrews 10:23 Let us hold fast the profession of [our] faith without wavering; (for he [is] faithful that promised;)

Ephesians 6:10-17 Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might. Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high [places]. Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace; Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God.
